

**ORDINANCE NO. 2006-4**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 72  
OF THE NASHVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Nashville has received information concerning the state of traffic control in the Town of Nashville, and

**WHEREAS**, after considering this information, deems it advisable to amend Chapter 72 of the Nashville Code of Ordinances,

Chapter 72 of the Nashville Code of Ordinances is amended by adding the following to **Schedule III**:


<u>Stop Location</u>	<u>Intersection</u>
Molly's Lane: Eastbound Lane	Bittersweet Lane
Molly's Lane: Westbound Lane	Bittersweet Lane

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED THAT**, if any section or provision of the Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, provisions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. Additionally, should any provisions of Chapter 72 be in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance, this Ordinance shall prevail. Any provision of Chapter 72 not amended by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Town Council of the Town of Nashville.






