**1) CALL TO ORDER** by Councilmember King at 6:35pm.


**2) KELLEY HILL WATER PRESSURE ISSUE DISCUSSION**


Town Superintendent Bush presented an outline to those present regarding the Kelley Hill water pressure. Discussion of options to increase the water pressure to this area. Town Superintendent Bush asked Monroe Water Corporation to increase the pressure they send to Nashville Water and Monroe Water Corporation advised they could not do this. Option number one will be to install minimal pumping facilities. Option number two would install a larger booster station at the base of Kelley Hill drive and install a parallel three inch line to the existing line. Option three is to repair and upgrade the Schooner Booster station. The fourth option is to repair Schooner station and doing option one at the top of the hill. The last option is to repair Schooner station and then install a large pumping station at the top of the hill. Discussion. Town Superintendent Bush intends to have the cost of each of these options by the next Council meeting.


