

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-02

WHEREAS, the Town Council is cognizant of a need to encourage local and tourist participation in art, craft and trade festivals and other similar activities on public property and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council believes that itinerant merchants and vendors, artists and crafts people who sell their wares are an integral part of such community activity and that such activity should be encouraged by simplifying the licensing procedure.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:


Section 116 of the Nashville Town Code be and is hereby amended to include the following exception:

116.45 Festival Exception


Itinerant merchants who participate in festivals or similar activities which have been pre-approved by the Town Council and which have a representative or fiscal agent who can handle the application process may be licensed for a period of up to seven consecutive days for a single payment of \$15.00 per merchant.

The holder of a license under this exception shall be permitted to conduct business on public streets, alleys, sidewalks or parking lots within the area designated by the Town Council in its approval of the festival for which the merchant's license has been issued.




