

TOWN OF NASHVILLE ORDINANCE NO. 2006-02

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE PARKING SCHEDULE AND NASHVILLE
PARKING ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Town Council that there exists a potential for both vehicular and pedestrian traffic congestion at the intersection of Van Buren and Franklin Streets; and


WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to alleviate the potential for said congestion and to better service the merchants located along Franklin street; and

WHEREAS, the Town council is aware that the horse drawn carriage rides provide interest and color to the community which is beneficial both to the merchants of the Town of Nashville and to its citizens.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED that the parking schedule which appears on page 19 and page 21 of the Nashville Code of Ordinances be amended to show the establishment of a sixty foot carriage stand commencing twenty-five feet from the intersection of Van Buren and Franklin Streets and extending along the north side of West Franklin Street for a distance of sixty feet. That an additional forty foot loading zone be established on the same side of same street commencing at the westerly end of the carriage stand designated herein.

That all portions of Ordinances No. 1995-1 and 1995-7 that are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.






