

ORDINANCE 2006-09

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 153.06(B)
OF THE NASHVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Nashville Town Council that Section 153.026(B) of the Nashville Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows (deleted text is signified in ~~strike through~~ format; new text is signified in **bold** format):


(B) *Definition.* For the purpose of this section, the following definition shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.


COLORED LIGHTING. Any lighting inside a window display area of a business which is visible to pedestrian and vehicular traffic or which is on the outside of any business or outbuilding, which is any color other than white, clear or natural light such as neon, argon, xenon, helium or fluorescent lighting which is used in and of itself as a lighting mechanism, or in combination with any coloring process which produces colored lighting, including but no limited to painted tubing or plastic sheathing or any type which would produce colored lighting. However, this shall not include any official court or public lighting of the flag, emblem insignia of a government or otherwise when displayed for official purposes. Additionally, this section shall not apply to seasonal ~~or Christmas~~ lighting between ~~November 1~~ **September 15** and January 15.


This amendment shall take effect upon its adoption by the Nashville Town Council.






