

NASHVILLE ORDINANCE NO 2007-03  
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 93.008 OF THE NASHVILLE CODE OF  
ORDINANCES (SNOW REMOVAL ENFORCEMENT)

Whereas, despite strong evidence of global warming, it is anticipated that snow will fall on the town of Nashville, Indiana, during the months of December, January, February and, sometimes, November and March for the foreseeable future; and


Whereas, during the winter of 2006 and 2007 the town council has been concerned with the enforcement of Town Ordinance 93.007 and 93.008 as it pertains to property owners' duty to remove snow from sidewalks.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED that 93.008 be amended by the addition of an additional section henceforth known as 93.008 (C), which should read as follows:


93.008(C). Instead of or in addition to imposing the fine set forth above, the Town may, at its discretion, remove or contract for the removal of the snow, and the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town shall make a certified statement of the costs incurred by the Town in the removal. The statement shall be delivered to the owner of the property by the Town Marshall, or by certified mail, and the owner shall have 10 days within which to pay the amount to the Clerk-Treasurer.

If the property owner fails to pay the sum within the time prescribed, a certified copy of the statement of costs shall be filed in the County Auditor's Office of the County where the real estate is located, and the Auditor shall place the amount claimed on the tax duplicate against the lands of the owner affected by the work, and the amount shall be collected as taxes are collected, and when collected shall be disbursed to the General Fund of the Town.


