WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Nashville, Indiana hereby accepts with deep gratitude the restricted donation from Patricia D. Millay: and

WHEREAS, Patricia worked for the Town of Nashville for 10 years. She began her tenure as an Administrative Assistant in the Town Manager's office. As her career progressed she learned every facet of the Public Works Department both inside and outside of the office, ultimately becoming a certified water operator. Not only was Patricia dedicated to the town during work hours she often donated time toward community services such as the 125th Anniversary of the Town.

WHEREAS, Patricia created an award winning town float for the Spring Blossom Festival Parade and willingly used her creative talents to design the artwork for the Abe Martin Street Banners.

WHEREAS, Patricia's talents were a great asset to many projects in town and in the community. Even after she decided to pursue other interests her dedication to the town was always evident.


WHEREAS, Patricia bequeathed \$2,500 to the Town of Nashville to be used specifically for the 4th of July Holiday decorations and the flag replacement program.




