WHEREAS, the grant agreement requires the Town Council to pass a resolution authorizing one member of the Town Council to execute the agreement.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED by the Town Council of Nashville, Indiana:


Section 1. That Town Council President Roger Kelso be authorized to execute the grant agreement with the Indiana Homeland Security Foundation.


Section 2. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its adoption and passage.




